It investigates key issues and themes of Belgian-Turkish migration by looking at the legal and social history, national and European policy, the present cultural diversity, identity and ethnicity, transmigration and return migration, as well as artistic responses and perceptions in film, literature, visual arts and theatre. Hence, the symposium aims to contribute to the debates about the sociological memory that binds Turkey and Belgium for over 50 years.
